PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Greenwich, NY DMS10 switch are associated with CLLI code GNWCNYGWDS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

- All references to the Albany, NY Packet End Office (PEO) switch are associated with CLLI code ALBYNYSSPS1 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Greenwich, NY DMS10 switch, located at 14 Hill Street, Greenwich, NY 12834, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Albany, NY PEO switch, located at 158 State Street, Albany, NY 12207. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Albany, NY PEO switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Greenwich, NY DMS10 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Albany, NY PEO switch.

All ASRs for the Albany, NY PEO switch must be received no later than February 15, 2024 to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Greenwich, NY DMS10 switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Greenwich, NY DMS10 switch (**on or after April 1, 2024**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the one (1) native code currently served by the Greenwich, NY DMS10 switch to reflect the Albany, NY PEO switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Albany, NY PEO switch must carry the project code of GNWCNYGWDS0.
