PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Madrid, NY DMS100 Remote switch are associated with CLLI code MDRDNYMKRS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Syracuse, NY Packet End Office (PEO) switch are associated with CLLI code SYRCNYSUPS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Madrid, NY DMS100 Remote switch, located at 1828 State Highway 345, Madrid, NY 13660, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Syracuse, NY PEO switch, located at 201 S. State Street, Syracuse, NY 13202. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Syracuse, NY PEO switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Madrid, NY DMS100 Remote switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Syracuse, NY PEO switch.

All ASRs for the Syracuse, NY PEO switch must be received no later than November 22, 2024, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Madrid, NY DMS100 Remote switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Madrid, NY DMS100 Remote switch (on or after January 2, 2025). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the one (1) native code currently served by the Madrid, NY DMS100 Remote switch to reflect the Syracuse, NY PEO switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Syracuse, NY PEO switch must carry the project code of MDRDNYMKRS0.
