PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Waverly PA 5ESS switch are associated with CLLI code PHLAPAWVDS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Market PA C20 switch are associated with CLLI code PHLAPAMKPS2 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Waverly PA 5ESS switch, located at 6468 N. Broad Street, Philadelphia, PA 19126, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Market PA C20 switch, located at 900 Race Street, Philadelphia, PA 19107. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Market PA C20 switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Waverly PA 5ESS switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Market PA C20 switch.

All ASRs for the Market PA C20 switch must be received no later than January 10, 2025, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Waverly PA 5ESS switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Waverly PA 5ESS switch (on or after February 1, 2025). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the nine (9) native codes currently served by the Waverly PA 5ESS switch to reflect the Market PA C20 switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Market PA C20 switch must carry the project code of PHLAPAWVDS0.
