PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Winthrop, MA DMS100 switch are associated with CLI code WNTHMAMADS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Newton, MA C20 switch are associated with CLI code NWTNMAWAPS1 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Winthrop, MA DMS100 switch, located at 30 Madison Avenue, Winthrop, MA 02152, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Newton, MA C20 switch, located at 787 Washington Street, Newton, MA 02460. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Newton, MA C20 switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Winthrop, MA DMS100 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Newton, MA C20 switch.

All ASRs for the Newton, MA C20 switch must be received no later than December 2, 2024, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Winthrop, MA DMS100 switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Winthrop, MA DMS100 switch (**on or after February 1, 2025**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the two (2) native codes currently served by the Winthrop, MA DMS100 switch to reflect the Newton, MA C20 switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Newton, MA C20 switch must carry the project code of WNTHMAMADS0.
